

PROCEDURE FOR INSTALLATION OF TRANSPONDER/TRACKER

1. Dh7000 to be deposited into the First Gulf Bank. There is only one branch in Dubai, Sheikh Zayed Road between Cadillac and Jeep showrooms, near Eemaar Gold Souk. Banking hours are from 8am to 1pm. Deposit slips must reflect:
Account title: Coast Guard Group – E-Pass
Account No.: 101 100 1013068 079
Amount: AED7000,00
Information: Depositor's name (must be the registered owner of the boat/vessel) and mobile number
2. Now, you must drive to the Coast Guards' Head Quarters, Port Rashid, at the Creek mouth, Bur Dubai side. Don't go through Shindagha Tunnel stay on top and follow the road to the Coast Guard. This is a military area, so no cameras and no mobiles.
3. Don't forget to take with you copy of passport, copy of residence visa, two photo, copy of Emirates ID, copy of boat registration and of course your deposit slip.
4. Report to the Military Security Gate with identification, and they will guide you to Mr Monsour's office.
5. At Mr. Monsour's office arrange with him the installation of the tracker and he will give you an Affidavit and Undertaking Contract.
6. **The boat must be in the water to have the tracker fitted.** As far as I know the closest slipway is at the Jumeriah Fisherman Village, next to DOSC. Don't forget to report to Coast Guard before leaving the Fisherman Village.
7. It is about 15 to 20km to Port Rashid. Enter at the 3rd Port Entrance (at the black and white lighthouse). On entering the Port, go left and towards the Creek direction, approaching the jetty's where Coast Guards are moored. Park on the Port Entrance side of the very first jetty (south side).
8. Now go find Mr Monsour again and he will guide you to the workshop. It takes about 1 hour to install. **Do not depart until Mr Monsour has given you a letter of installation and photographs taken of the boat from both sides.**
Remember he only installs between 8h30 – 11.30am Sunday to Thursday. No prior booking required.
